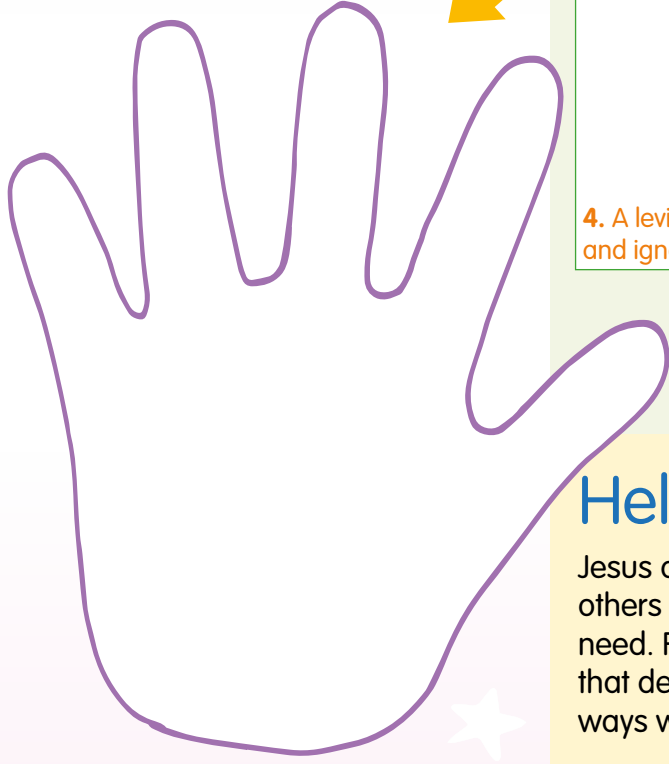






When we help another person, we are being a good neighbour



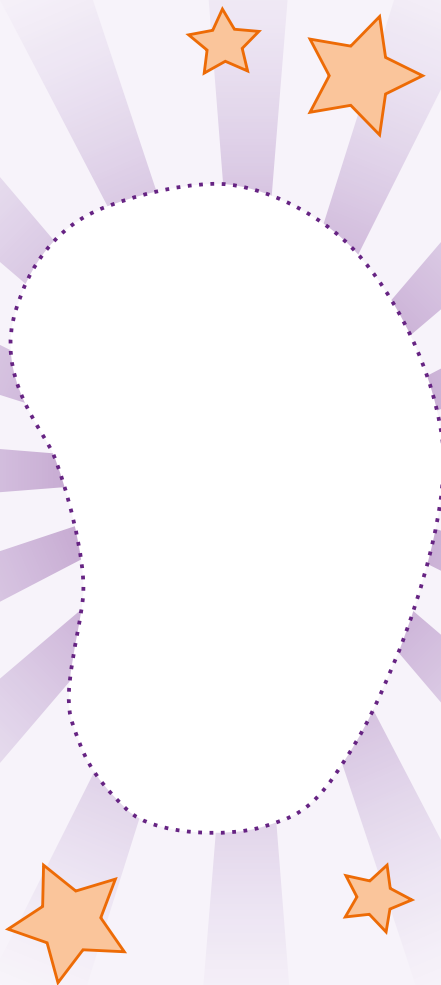

In the house of Martha and Mary

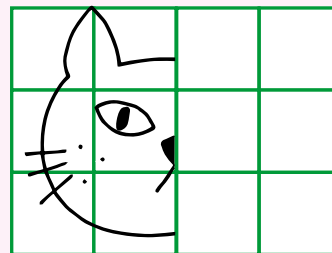
Here is Martha. She is very busy. How many things is she using? Link them to her with a line.



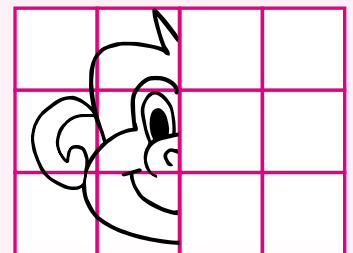
